ABOUT ENGAGE

Engage Miami builds civic equity and power through voter activation, civic education, leadership development, and local and state issue organizing. We center young voters and leaders ages 16-35, building young people's political power in majority Black and Latinx communities. Our mission is to build a more just, democratic, and sustainable Miami by developing a local culture of civic participation for young people that is bold, creative, and impactful.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Engage Miami is currently seeking Engage the Vote Student Influencers to join our voter and civic engagement program in Miami-Dade. Our goal is to civically engage and activate students and volunteers on college campuses to assist in building capacity, getting out the vote and relationship building to promote political progress. We are looking for self-starters who have a keen interest in civic engagement, democratic values, and a passion for political issues.

Engage the Vote Student Influencers will be responsible for learning about and addressing issues related to voting rights at the local, state, and federal levels. They will also participate in civic engagement by leading efforts on their campus, helping students register and pledge to vote, sign up for vote by mail and assist with class presentations, volunteer recruitment and on-campus civic engagement events. The Student Influencers will be involved in direct voter outreach efforts such as phone and text banking. To facilitate their growth, they will also undergo civic leadership training development with Engage Miami staff and civic leaders.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Attend orientation and Engage Miami engagement trainings
- Attend mandatory check-in meetings with the Engage Coordinators and campus civic engagement administrators as needed
- Assist with delivering classroom presentations, facilitating effective campus partnerships, and recruiting student volunteers
- Participate in voter engagement activities including attending civic events, phone banking, tabling, and canvassing
- Represent Engage Miami at campus events and orientations



- Foster with professors, administrators, and student leaders to increase awareness of Engage Miami's civic engagement programs

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a student enrolled at a South Florida campus
- Commitment to building the power of young people in South Florida
- Organized, motivated, and responsible, bringing enthusiasm and energy to educating and engaging fellow students and coordinating with faculty and staff with great follow through
- Strong communication skills, including comfort with class presentations, one-on-one conversations, and motivating and training volunteers, with a commitment to sharing our message and following nonpartisan guidelines
- Interested in elections and civic engagement, with a desire to learn, grow, and develop as a civic leader on campus
- Willing to work in person, on and off-campus (*as well as conducting meetings and trainings remotely*), committed to scheduling 10 hours per week

The priority deadline for submitting applications is **Wednesday, August 30th**. Applicants who meet the qualifications may receive an invitation for an interview.
