



## **Young People's Policy Priorities Organizing Fellowship**

Summer & Fall 2020

Engage Miami is seeking candidates for our Young People's Policy Priorities (YPPP) Organizing Fellowship. Fellows will help drive Engage's campaign to advance real solutions to critical local issues – housing justice, climate justice, safe communities, transportation that works and democracy done right – this year at the local level. You will meet new people and join forces with your peers, advocate to elected officials and learn how to create change and build people power. As part of helping drive our campaign, Fellows will conduct outreach, be responsible for their own project and participate in trainings and development sessions. Fellows will develop organizing skills such as outreach and recruitment, research, event coordination, relationship building and campaign organizing. Fellows will be supervised by the Organizing Director and Advocacy Organizer.

Engage Miami is a local, nonpartisan nonprofit organization. Our mission is to build a more just, democratic and sustainable Miami by developing a culture of civic participation for young people that is bold, creative, impactful and local.

Timeline: 5-month Fellowship through November 15th, 8-12 hours per week

Hourly rate: \$15/hour

Deadline for Applications: Priority deadline is June 3rd

- Applicants should be self-motivated, resourceful, well-organized and accountable, while bringing a sense of humor and fun to their work
- Have some experience working in advocacy, organizing or local issues
- We're looking for people who are passionate about Miami, excited about the potential young people have to change it and willing to do the hard work to bring people to the table.
- Must be a young person (16-35) in South Florida, open to students and non-students
