Engage Miami is seeking Civics305 Summer Fellows who are interested in electoral or non-profit work and leading efforts with Engage Miami. Civics305 Fellows will be learning how to assist and lead our Civics305 Focus Groups researching the perspectives and experiences of young people in Miami when it comes to civic engagement and social issues in Miami. You will help us in engaging, educating and activating peers around civic participation and local elections and campaigns, as well as discovering more about your own civic identity. Engage Miami will provide training, mentorship, and support towards becoming a force of change in your community.

Engage Miami is a local, nonprofit nonpartisan organization. Our mission is to build a more just, democratic, and sustainable Miami by developing a culture of civic participation for young people that is bold, creative, impactful and local.

Civics305 Fellows will lead in voter engagement efforts on campuses and in communities by:

- Facilitate research focus groups to make sure every young person's voice is heard
- Engage faculty to promote civic leadership in their classrooms
- Educate your peers through giving class presentations on elections, the census and how to take action

Timeline: 100 hours completed in ten weeks between June 8th - August 14th, an average of 10 hours per week.

Hourly rate: \$12.50/hour

Deadline for Spring Fellowship: Priority deadline is May 29th, 2020

Qualifications

- Student in South Florida ages 18 - 25 (not sure if you qualify? Please apply anyway or reach out with questions!)
- Responsible, organized, with strong time management skills
- Available for at least 10 hours weekly
- Willing to give 5-10 min class presentations on voter engagement (training will be provided)
- Interest in developing leadership, research, public speaking, and capacity for civic impact
- Strong fit for students interested in politics, nonprofits, education, research, and community engagement
