Engage Miami is seeking Civics305 Fall Fellows who are interested in electoral or non-profit work and leading efforts with Engage Miami. You will help us in engaging, educating, and activating faculty and peers around civic participation and local elections and campaigns, as well as discovering more about your own civic identity. Civics305 Fellows will lead our Civics305 In Focus group dialogues, researching the perspectives and experiences of young people when it comes to civic engagement and social issues in Miami. Engage Miami will provide training, mentorship, and support towards becoming a force of change in your community.

Engage Miami is a local, nonprofit nonpartisan organization. Our mission is to build a more just, democratic, and sustainable Miami by developing a culture of civic participation for young people that is bold, creative, impactful, and local.

Civics305 Fellows will lead in voter engagement efforts on campuses and in communities by:

- Engaging faculty to promote civic leadership in their classrooms
- Educating peers through class presentations on elections and how to take action
- Leading Civics305 In Focus discussions to deepen understanding of the experiences and engagement of young people in Miami-Dade
- Work with Engage staff to use digital engagement to spread the word about young leaders and voters, and the power we have to make change in Miami-Dade.

Timeline: Three month fellowship, start date September 8. 8-10 hours per week.

Hourly rate: \$12.50/hour

Deadline for Spring Fellowship: Priority deadline is August 15th, 2020

- Students in South Florida ages 18 - 25
- Responsible, organized, with strong time management skills
- Available for at least 10 hours weekly
- Willing to give 5-10 min class presentations on voter engagement (training will be provided)
- Interest in developing leadership, research, public speaking, and capacity for civic impact
- Strong fit for students interested in politics, nonprofits, education, research, and community engagement
